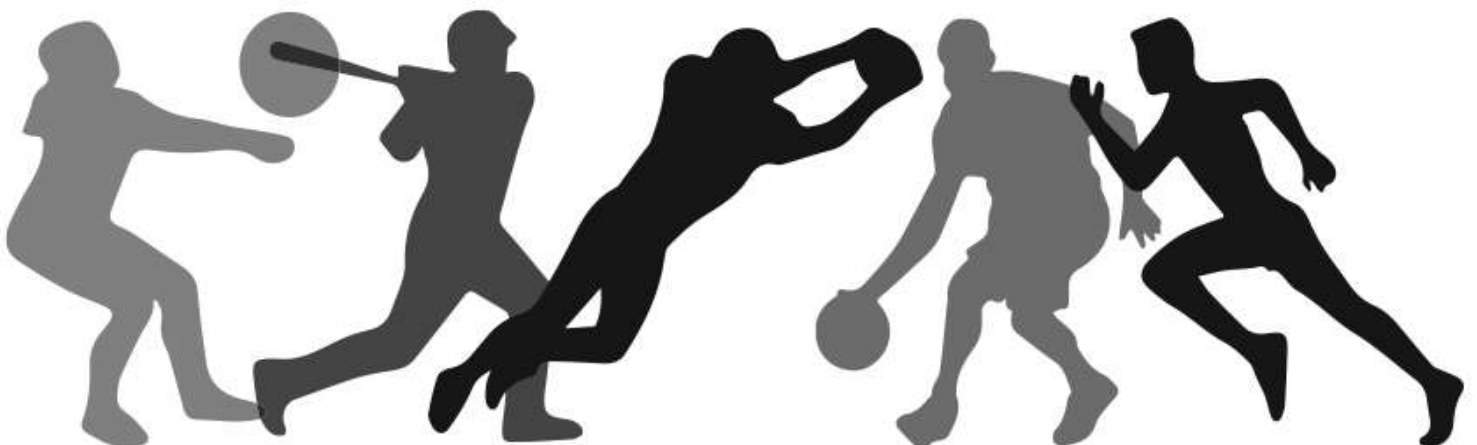

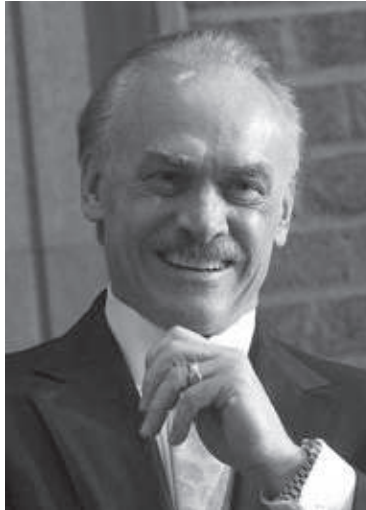

Guest Speaker

ROCKY BLEIER - "Bio"



Rocky Bleier's life story - a gripping tale of courage on both the football fields of America and the battle fields of Vietnam – has held audiences in rapt attention for years. Yet, the motivational message behind it, detailing how ordinary people can become extraordinary achievers, defines success in the new American century.

With the same optimism, sense of humor and steadfast determination that were his trademarks as a Pittsburgh Steelers running back, Rocky Bleier takes audiences from his early years through his professional career and talks about the lessons he learned along the way....lessons that we all can benefit from.

Not falling within the ideal of what a running back should look like, Bleier had to run harder and play smarter to be able to stand out. Despite his drive and ability to make the big play, the Pittsburgh Steelers only considered him a late round pick. But before the season ended that first year, he was drafted again...this time by the United States Army. At the height of the Vietnam War, Bleier was thrust into combat early and was seriously wounded when his platoon ran into an ambush. Receiving wounds from both rifle fire and grenade fragments in his legs, he was barely able to walk and his professional football career seemed to have ended before it began.

For more than two years, he drove himself. Little by little he overcame obstacles and fought his back. He not only made the Pittsburgh Steelers, but also eventually became a starting running back on a team that won four Super Bowls and became the greatest football team of the 20th century.

The hard lessons Rocky Bleier learned early in his life, which helped him, overcome adversity and reach his goals, have paid off after football. What makes Rocky Bleier so popular as a speaker is his ability to translate core values in his speech, "Be the Best You Can Be". With real-world practicality, he points out ways to reach new levels of inner-confidence.

Whether it is career development for corporate executives, enhancing sales and marketing skills for sales teams, offering inspiration for young professionals or practical advice to student athletes, Bleier's delivery is a winner. His message consistently brings audiences to their feet and re-energizes them for personal and work challenges ahead. His advice is not about avoiding life's twists and turns but conditioning one's self to lean into them and to incorporate the resulting energy in realizing goals.

 - Served with the 4th /31st of the 196th LIB of the Americal Division
 - Stationed in Chu Lai, South Vietnam located in I Corp
- August 1969 Wounded in Heip Duc
 - Awarded Purple Heart
 - Awarded Bronze Star
- 1970 Pittsburgh Steelers Injured Reserve
- 1971 Pittsburgh Steelers Taxi Squad
- 1972 Made the active roster for the Pittsburgh Steelers
- 1974 Earned a spot in the starting backfield
- 1975 Enjoyed one of the best games of his career against the Greenbay Packers...he rushed for 163 yards for the day.
- 1976 Rocky Bleier & Franco Harris became only the second pair of running backs from the same team to gain 1000 yards in the same season.
- 1977 Scored the "go-ahead" touchdown in Super Bowl XIII
- 1980 Retired from the Pittsburgh Steelers at the end of the 1980 season.
- 1980 – present President, Rocky Bleier, Inc.

EDDIE KAZAK

CECIL TOWNSHIP HIGH SCHOOL

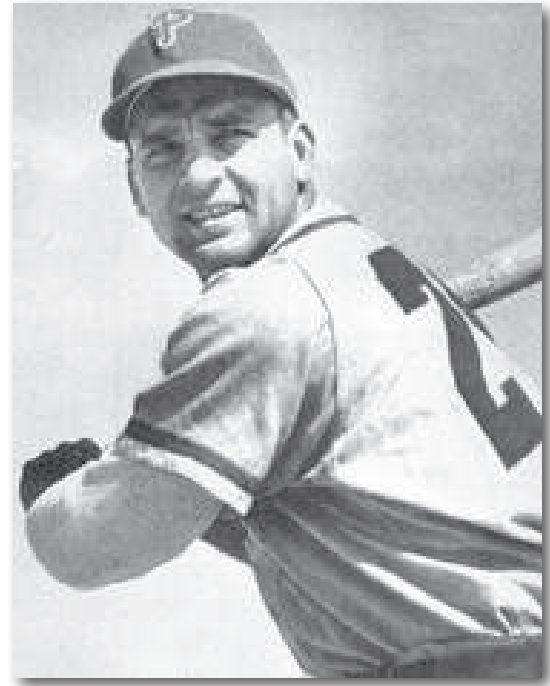
SPECIAL HONOREE - BASEBALL

- Born in Steubenville, Ohio, Kazak graduated from Cecil Township High School in 1938
- He made his major-league debut in September 1948 for the St. Louis Cardinals and his last MLB appearance was July 1, 1952 for Cincinnati
- Kazak was the starting third baseman for the 1949 National League All-Star team
- The 1949 season was Kazak's best in the big leagues. He had a career-high .304 batting average in 92 games. He hit six home runs and three triples
- In his lone MLB All-Star appearance, Kazak went two-for-two
- An injury in 1950 cost Kazak his starting position. In 93 games, he had 207 at bats, 42 as a pinch-hitter
- He was traded to Cincinnati in 1952. He had one hit in 13 at bats for the Reds, which ended his big-league career
- Kazak hit .273 in his career with 11 home runs and 71 RBI
- Kazak played professional baseball after his major league career ended
- He played his final professional game at age 40 in 1960 while playing for Austin in the Texas League
- He died in Austin, Texas December 15, 1999



ANDY SEMINICK

SPECIAL HONOREE - BASEBALL



- Born in Pierce, WV, his family moved to Muse, PA when Andy was 2-years-old
- In 1949, was the starting catcher for the National League All-Star team
- In that 1949 season, he hit 24 home runs and had 68 RBI
- In a game against Cincinnati June 2, Seminick hit two of the Phillies' five homers in the eighth inning
- He belted three HRs in the game. The five HRs in one inning hit by the Phillies in that game tied an MLB record, achieved first in June 1939 when the Giants turned the trick
- Andy was part of the Phillies' 1950 National League Champion "Whiz Kids." They won the title on the last day of the regular season, defeating Brooklyn in extra innings. They were swept in the World Series by the Yankees
- Seminick played 11 years with Philadelphia and three-plus seasons with Cincinnati
- In his 15-year career, he batted .243 with 164 home runs. An "Andy Seminick Night" was held in Philadelphia in 1956 between games of a Phillies-Reds doubleheader
- After retiring as a player, Seminick started a coaching career in 1957 with the Phillies' organization
- He coached for two years and then became a manager leading nine minor-league teams from 1959 through 1973
- Ninety of Seminick's former minor-league players reached the majors, including Hall of Fame third-baseman Mike Schmidt, Greg Luzinski, and Bob Boone, key players in the greatest era for the Phillies in the 1970s and early 1980s
- At the time of Andy Seminick's death in 2004, then-Phillies president David Montgomery said of him: *"As big and tough as he was as a player, Andy was as nice a person you ever wanted to know."*



1939 WAYNESBURG COLLEGE FOOTBALL

SPECIAL HONOREE

Played in the first American football game ever televised

The team played highly-regarded Fordham, September 30, 1939 at Triborough Stadium at New York City's Randall's Island. Fordham won the game, 34-7, after Waynesburg took the lead in the game

Bobby Brooks scored on a 63-yard run on the third play of the game for Waynesburg to shock the pre-season national champion favorite Rams

The attendance was announced at 9,000

NBC's television signal carried a 55-mile radius. People in just a few homes in New York, those with special sets, actually had the opportunity to watch the game. A good, 14-inch television, the Clifton, sold for \$600 then

The Yellow Jackets dressed 42 players, including Mo Scarry and John "Jack" Wiley

The estimated televised audience was 500

The team, which dubbed itself the "Wolfmen," in reference Frank Wolf, head coach, stayed over in Harrisburg before arriving in New York a day before the game

The game was nearly knockoff the air in the fourth-quarter when Fordham's John Stefanic was knocked out of bounds and plunged into the camera, nearly overturning it

NBC invested, it was said, \$100,000 in the project — with little return

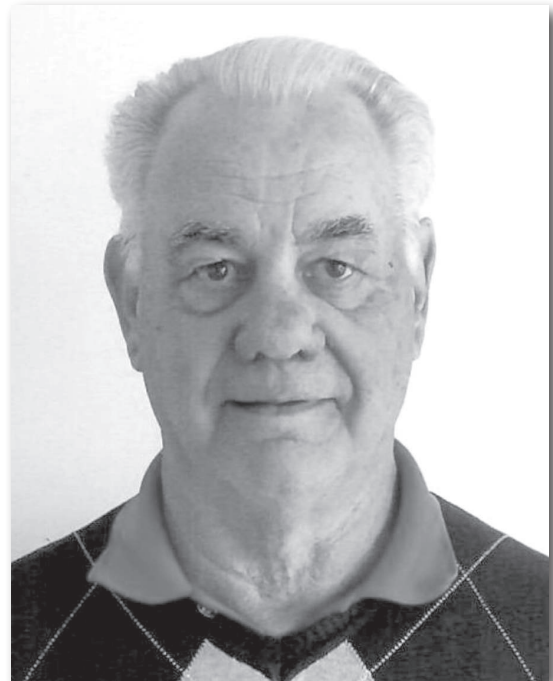

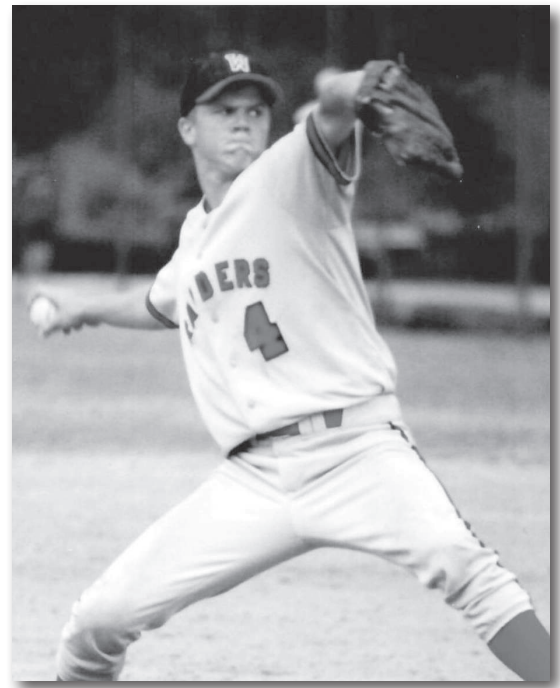

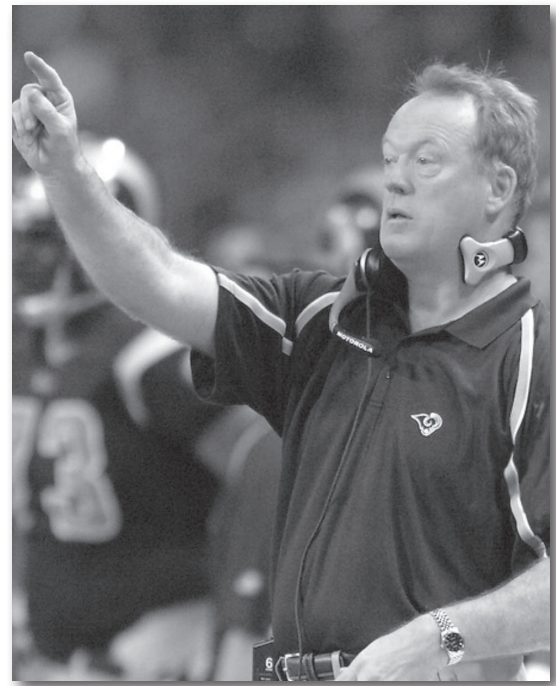

Nominees must have been active participants as team members, coaches, individuals, managers, all sport officials or promotional, administrative or new media personnel.

All who have paid their \$10.00 membership fee are invited to attend chapter meetings and assist in the identification of potential award recipients. Members who have attained their 21st birthday and who have attended a minimum of four previous meetings in the current year; shall be eligible to vote for the election of chapter officers and other chapter business.
